The Historic Snowstorm of 2016

The largest snowstorm since 1988 hit Sumner County January 20-22, with more than a foot of snow in some areas. The National Weather Service called it “The Historic Snowstorm of 2016.” While schools and businesses were closed, road crews worked around the clock .



From the Director

Spring has sprung and with it, good weather for construction projects. One of these is the CDBG construction project in the Chippendale area. CDBG is short for Community Development Block Grant. This is a grant the City receives from the Federal government once the City reaches a certain population. The last census allowed the City access to these funds. The amount is set mainly on population but also on income levels and other factors.

The City receives approximately \$200,000 for construction annually. The Planning Department is instrumental in administering CDBG with the Federal government. Public Works develops construction projects in designated areas. These are given to Planning, discussed and put into the main CDBG document. At this time, Public Works is finding projects to rebuild and replace curb lines, drainage pipes, and fix drainage practices that were utilized thirty years ago but are not the best practices now. ❖ Holiday Garbage Collection - Weeks of Memorial Day, May 30 & Monday, July 4

Monday/Thurs will be Tues/Friday
Tues/Friday will be Weds/Saturday

❖ What size can be left at the side or back of the house for collection?

The can cannot be taller than 42” and everything must be in plastic bags (grocery bags are ok). Any extra bags or boxes not in a can need to be at the road for pick up.
