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Temporary Building Sign Regulations City of Hendersonville, Tennessee

The entire text of the Sign Ordinance can be found in Section 13 of The Zoning Ordinance of the City of Hendersonville and the Hendersonville Planning Region.

Temporary Building Signs are not allowed in the following districts:
ALL R (Residential), O (Office) and NC (Neighborhood Commercial).

Regulations for OT-C, GC, MXC, HC and I Zoning Districts

- 1 temporary building sign allowed per business
- 40 square feet maximum size
- May be displayed for 60 days per year (may be split into no more than 4 periods of 15 days)
- Permit is required (\$25)
- In instances where the sign advertises a business/organization/event that is not located on the lot where the sign is to be located, a letter giving permission for the display of the sign from the owner of the property must be included with the permit application. A permit will not be issued without verification that the owner has approved the display of the sign.
- Must be displayed flat against the wall of the building. May not be erected on an existing sign, poles, or columns.
