KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT WE, THE UNDERSIGNED,

authorized to do business in the State of Tennessee, are held and firmly bound unto the City of Hendersonville,
Sumner County, Tennessee (City of Hendersonville) as Obligee, for the benefit of the City of Hendersonville,
and also for and on behalf of the owner(s) of property on which work is performed by the Principal pursuant to a
permit issued under this bond, or, for work performed by the Principal for which a permit should have been
obtained prior to the commencement of such activity, we hereby bind ourselves, our heirs, executors,
administrators, successors and assigns, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents, in the full and penal sum
of _____.

WHEREAS, the above bonded Principal has applied to the City of Hendersonville to be registered pursuant to
SECTION 20, CHAPTER 10 of the Hendersonville Municipal Code.

NOW THEREFORE, this obligation is to secure the following: That the Principal shall in all respects comply
with and conform to all codes, laws and ordinances of the City of Hendersonville, relating to but not limited to
excavation and construction in public right-of-way, building, grading, plumbing, gas/mechanical, housing, fire,
health and zoning: that this obligation shall further bind the Principal and Surety for any damage to property of
the City of Hendersonville resulting from contractors of the Principal, such as but not limited to streets, roads,
curbs, gutters, water, sewer and storm water drainage lines, sidewalks, alleys, traffic signs and signals, and for
the costs of repairs incurred by property owners resulting from the failure of the Principal to comply with and
conform to the above mentioned codes, laws and ordinances of the City of Hendersonville.

The term of this bond is continuous; however, the Surety shall have the right to cancel this bond at any time by a
written notice stating when the cancellation shall take effect and served upon or sent by certified mail to the
Department of Codes Administration of the City of Hendersonville at least ten (10) days prior to the effective
date of the cancellation. The liability of the Surety shall continue to attach to work performed pursuant to any
permit issued prior to the termination date of the bond even if the non-complying act should occur after the
termination date of the bond. The liability of the Surety for any and all claims, suits or actions under this bond
shall not exceed the bond penalty as set forth above. Regardless of the number of years this bond may remain in
force, the liability of the Surety shall not be cumulative, and the aggregate liability of the Surety for all claims,
suits or action under this bond shall not exceed the face amount.

No right of action shall accrue by reason of the Bond, to or for the use or benefit of any one whatsoever other
than the Obligee named herein.
